- 10. Unfinished Business The next state convention will be in 2002, in Ventura. The grand prize is a 7-day vacation sailing in Alaska including airfare, second prize is \$ 750.00 gift certificate at Sears, and the third prize is registration and lodging for 2 for the convention of 25-26 April 2003 or \$ 300.00.
