What is a "blast" class?

- People who attend our Intro to Square Dancing on Friday evening and can't wait to learn more!
- Come with family or friends or come by yourself -- you do not need to come with a partner.

What will I be able to do after taking this class?

This class covers the material that would typically be covered during the first 8-10 weeks of a regular square dance class. After completing this class, you will be able to:

- Attend the Sunday evening closing dance of the Jubilee, our annual square dance festival. (This will be a "multi-level" dance, with some dancing for beginners along with dancing for more experienced dancers.)
- Dance in the "newer dancer" sessions at other major festivals like Harvest Hoedown in Yuba City.
- Join any of the regular weekly classes that started in September or October.
- Attend a follow-on blast class to learn the rest of the Mainstream calls.

The class will meet all day, from **10am to 5pm**, with two breaks. A food vendor will be located on-site for you to buy lunch or a snack. No special clothing is required, but please wear comfortable shoes. Cost for the class is \$10/person. Parking is free for students taking this class -- enter through **Gate D** from Monterey Road.
